



A NEW TYPE OF EXPANDED CHILDCARE IS BEING OFFERED IN OUR FAMILY CHILD CARE HOMES!

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PROGRAM

- Spouse of Military Member.
- Active Duty or Reserve/Guard in activated status.
- Sponsor must be at work, on directed crew rest, or must attend the appointment with the spouse.
- No other adult in the household available to provide care.
- Spouse must be attending an approved appointment.

*An ECC form with the active duty members supervisor's signature along with verification of an appointment is needed to qualify.

Receive 40 hours per month of free child care for military families with a disabled child.


